Subject: Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore - Recognition of MD(T.B.& Resp. Diseases/Pulmonary Medicine) qualification for 01 seat in respect of students being trained at M S Ramaiah Medical College, Bangalore.

Sir/ Madam,

I am directed to state that the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee of this Council at its meeting held on 23.06.2017 considered the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (31/05/2017) in pursuance to Order dated 10/04/2017 passed by the Hon'ble Karnataka High Court at Bengaluru along with the Council Assessor's Report (September, 2014; June, 2015 and May, 2016) and compliance dated 15/05/2017 submitted by the college authorities on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MD(T.B.& Resp. Diseases/Pulmonary Medicine) qualification for 01 seat at M S Ramaiah Medical College, Bangalore granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore. The Committee decided as under:-

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (31/05/2017) in pursuance to Order dated 10/04/2017 passed by the Hon'ble Karnataka High Court at Bengaluru along with the Council Assessor's Report (September, 2014; June, 2015 and May, 2016) and compliance dated 15/05/2017 submitted by the college authorities and decided to recommend to the Central Government that MD(T.B.& Resp. Diseases/Pulmonary Medicine) qualification for 01 seat granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore in respect of students being trained at M S Ramaiah Medical College, Bangalore be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee further decided that the recognition so granted shall be for a maximum period of 5 years from the date of Notification upon which the Institute shall have to apply for renewal of recognition. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the Postgraduate Course.

You are therefore requested to notify the above qualification at the earliest.
