I am directed to state that the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee of this Council at its meeting held on 29.05.2018 considered the Compliance verification Report (04.05.2018) and Council Assessor's Report(s) (July, 2017) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available for Recognition of DM(Gastroenterology) qualification against increased intake from 01 to 02 seats at M S Ramaiah Medical College, Bangalore granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore. The Committee decided as under:-

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Compliance verification Report (04.05.2018) and Council Assessor's Report(s) (July, 2017) and decided to recommend to the Central Government that DM(Gastroenterology) qualification against increased intake from 01 to 02 seats granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore in respect of students being trained at M S Ramaiah Medical College, Bangalore be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee further decided that the recognition so granted shall be for a maximum period of 5 years from the date of Notification upon which the Institute shall have to apply for renewal of recognition.
