Consideration of Compliance Verification Assessment with regard to continuance of recognition of MBBS degree granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore in respect of students being trained at M.S. Ramaiah Medical College, Bangalore.

Sir/ Madam,

I am directed to inform that the compliance verification assessment of the physical and the other teaching facilities available for continuance of recognition of MBBS degree granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore in respect of students being trained at M.S. Ramaiah Medical College, Bangalore was carried out by the Council Assessors on 29th April, 2016. The compliance verification assessment report (29th April, 2016) along with the previous assessment reports (3.2.2016 & 26th Aug, 2014) was considered by the Executive Committee at its meeting held on 13.05.2016. The following recommendations of the Executive Committee was approved by the General Body of the Council at its meeting held on 22nd November, 2016:-

"The Executive Committee of the Council considered the compliance verification assessment report (29th April, 2016) along with the previous assessment reports (3.2.2016 & 26th Aug, 2014) and decided to recommend that recognition of MBBS degree granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore in respect of students being trained at M.S. Ramaiah Medical College, Bangalore be continued restricting the number of admission to 150 (One Hundred fifty) students.

The Executive Committee further decided that the attention of the institute be drawn to Sections 8(3)(2), 8(3)(3) & 8(3)(4) of the Establishment of Medical Colleges Regulations (Amendment), 2010 (Part II) dated 16th April 2010 and act accordingly at appropriate time, which reads as under:-

8 (3) ...

(2) The recognition so granted to an Undergraduate Course for award of MBBS degree shall be for a maximum period of 5 years, upon which it shall have to be renewed.

(3) The procedure for 'Renewal' of recognition shall be same as applicable for the award of recognition.

(4) Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required in sub-clause (a) supra shall invariably result in stoppage of admissions to the concerned Undergraduate Course of MBBS at the said institute."

The above decision of the General Body has been approved by the Oversight Committee on 28.04.2017.

It is further to inform you that your institution is fully responsible to fulfill and maintain norms including the infrastructure both physical and human resource, teaching faculty and clinical material etc. throughout, as stipulated in Regulation of Medical Council of India. In case false/wrong declaration of fabricated documents have been used for procuring the approval of Continuation of recognition by the Council and the said misconduct is brought to notice or comes to the knowledge of MCI at any stage, your institution is liable not to be considered for approval of continuation of recognition with the annual intake capacity of 150 students and this approval is also liable to be revoked. Besides, MCI is entitled to take all such measures against you and your college/institution as permissible under the law.
