I am directed to state that the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee of this Council at its meeting held on 24.04.2018 considered the Compliance verification Report (26.02.2018) and Council Assessor's Report(s) (June, 2017) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available for Recognition of MD(Anaesthesia) qualification against increased intake from 06 to 08 seats at Institute of M S Ramaiah Medical College, Bangalore granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore. The Committee decided as under:-

*"The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Compliance Verification Assessment (26/02/2018) along with the Council Assessor's Report (June, 2017) and compliance dated 12/10/2017 submitted by the college authorities and decided to recommend to the Central Government that MD(Anaesthesia) qualification against increased intake from 06 to 08 seats granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore in respect of students being trained at M S Ramaiah Medical College, Bangalore be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956.*

*The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee further decided that the recognition so granted shall be for a maximum period of 5 years from the date of Notification upon which the Institute shall have to apply for renewal of recognition. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the Postgraduate Course."*

The above minutes of the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee have been approved by the Oversight Committee vide their letter dated 04.05.2018.

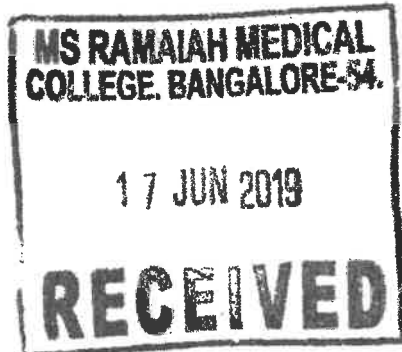

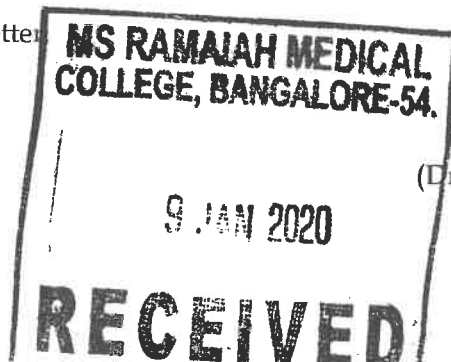
