I am to state that the General Body of this Council at its meeting held on 26-27/03/2015 considered the Council Assessor's Report (August, 2014) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at M S Ramaiah Medical College, Bangalore for the award of M.Ch(Paediatric Surgery) qualification for 01 seat under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore. The Council approved the following recommendations of the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee, which I am directed to convey herewith for your information and necessary action:-

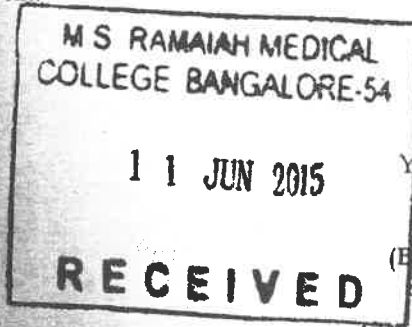
"The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Assessment Report (August, 2014) and decided to recommend that M.Ch(Paediatric Surgery) qualification granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore in respect of students being trained at M S Ramaiah Medical College, Bangalore be recognized for 1 (One) seat and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee further decided that the recognition so granted shall be for a maximum period of 5 years from the date of Notification upon which the Institute shall have to apply for renewal of recognition. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the postgraduate course."

You are therefore requested to notify the above qualification at the earliest.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer your proposal for Increase of seats in M.Ch. (Paediatrics Surgery) course at M.S. Ramaiah Medical College, Bangalore, Karnataka under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka u/s 10A of the I.M.C Act, 1956 for the academic year 2020-21.

It is to inform that the Board of Governors considered the Council Assessor's report (01/01/2020) together with the recommendations of the PG Expert Group (BoG) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at M.S. Ramaiah Medical College, Bangalore, Karnataka under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka for Increase of seats in M.Ch. (Paediatrics Surgery) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2020-21 and decided as under:

"The Board of Governors considered the Council Assessor's Report (01/01/2020) together with the recommendations of the PG Expert Group (BoG) and decided to issue Letter of Permission for Increase of seats in M.Ch. (Paediatrics Surgery) course at M.S. Ramaiah Medical College, Bangalore, Karnataka under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2020-2021 from 01(One) to 03(Three) students per year till the first batch admitted against the increased number appears in the final examination of the said course. The Teaching Institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification for the additional increased intake at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956."

It is also to inform that the Board of Governors further decided that Letter of Permission for Increase of seats in M.Ch. (Paediatrics Surgery) course from 01(One) to 03(Three) seats as per available facilities, with prospective effect i.e. from the academic session 2020-21 at M.S. Ramaiah Medical College, Bangalore, Karnataka u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956 may be issued.
