I am to state that the General Body of this Council at its meeting held on 01/10/2015 considered the Council Assessor's Report (July, 2014) and compliance dated 21/04/2015 submitted by the College authorities on the physical and other teaching facilities available at M S Ramaiah Medical College, Bangalore for the award of M.Ch(Vascular Surgery) qualification for 02 seats under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore. The Council approved the following recommendations of the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee, which I am directed to convey herewith for your information and necessary action:-

"The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (July, 2014) and compliance dated 21/04/2015 submitted by the college authorities and decided to recommend to the Central Government that M.Ch(Vascular Surgery) qualification for 02 seats granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore in respect of students being trained at M S Ramaiah Medical College, Bangalore be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee further decided that the recognition so granted shall be for a maximum period of 5 years from the date of Notification upon which the Institute shall have to apply for renewal of recognition. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the Postgraduate Course."

You are therefore requested to notify the above qualification at the earliest.

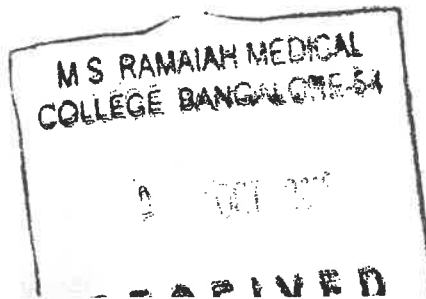

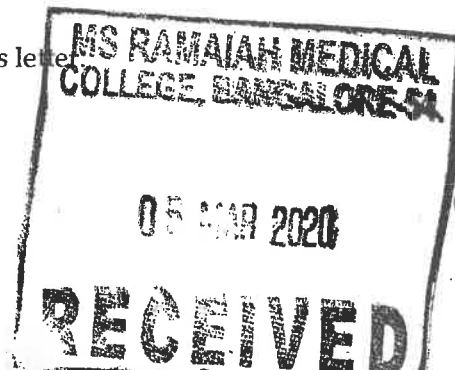
Sir/Madam,

This permission for increase of seats and admission of students against the increased intake is till such time the first batch of students admitted against the above course appears for the final examination in the subject. The college authorities may take up the matter for recognition of the qualification under section 11(2) of the IMC Act at the time of first batch admitted against the sanctioned intake appears for final year examination with the Central Government.
